They came together through divine intervention. Sapphira, a half-breed Jewish outcast, and Domidicus, a high-ranking Roman army officer sworn to carry out his emperors edicts. Caught up in the intrigue of Herods court, they witness the cruelty and immorality of the dying king until a predestined encounter with the Christ Child changes their lives. Committing an act of treason by allowing the Holy Family to escape to Egypt, Domidicus is tried and condemned for his actions and Sapphiras newborn is abducted by Phaesalis, Herods daughter-in-law. Separated by cruel captivity, imprisonment and crucifixion, their lives take divergent courses until many years later when they come face-to-face with the adult Christ who once again miraculously enters their lives.
